Bellwoods An IPA Ontario

Style: Hazy IPA

This all came together in 2012, with Bellwoods opening as a small brewery and pub in downtown Toronto. This Hazy IPA is hopped with a blend of Simcoe, Citra, Rakau and Loral hops. It's boasting a fusion of orange juice, fresh papaya, honeydew nectarine, limeade and a hint of elderflower.



Field House British Columbia Style: Hazy Pale 473ml

Field House Brewing is a community-focused craft brewery located in East Abbotsford. Established in 2015. they have certainly built a reputation for producing 'top notch' beers, leaning towards perfection. This Hazy Pale certainly carries some juiciness, showcasing a mix of Strata, Nectaron, Cryo and Citra hops. It offers a refreshing mix of citrus, orange zest, grapefruit and fresh guava with a hint of creamy caramel malt.

Refined Fool Single Friend

Style: Cold IPA

Located in Sarnia, Refined Fool Brewing Co has certainly come a long way, from their humble beginnings using DIY converted maple syrup drums, to brew their own magic. This beer called 'Single Friend', is unbound by the rules of ordinary IPA's. It's classified as a Cold IPA, which is cold-filtered and lagered to make it crisper, cleaner and seriously crushable, for a lovely twist on a classic.

Small Gods Forbidden Territory British Columbia Style: Single Hop IPA 473ml

Small Gods is a family-owned-and-operated brewery, designed to fit into the community of Sidney by the Sea. Sidney is a tiny seaside village, beside the Swartz Bay ferry, that connects South Vancouver Island to the mainland. 'Forbidden Territory' is a delicious IPA, brewed exclusively with Nelson Sauvin hops and a collaboration with Ace Brewing. Expect loads of passion fruit for a hop bomb of a brew.






Four Winds Europa British Columbia Style: Dark Lager 473ml

Situated just off the banks of the Fraser River in Delta, is a small brewery owned by the Mills family. They opened their doors in 2013 and certainly play an important role in the BC Craft World. 'Europa' is the Czech equivalent of a dark lager, brewed in the tradition of Prague's 500-year lager. It's clean and crisp, delivering notes of crisp apple, dates, figs and dark chocolate with a hint of malt.

Style: West Coast IPA

Alesmith Brewing was founded in a small single-unit space in the commercial district of Miramar, San Diego. From their courteous beginnings in 1995, they have continued to be recognized with numerous awards both locally and abroad. This IPA is a classic West Coast style, boasting a huge hop profile from Columbus and Citra hops. It's tart and tangv showcasing a mix of green apple, grapefruit, white grape and lemon curd with a hint of pine resin and caramel malt.
