Camp Survival Camp British Columbia Style: Triple IPA 473ml

Located in the Fraser Valley in BC, Camp is a community-based brewery and tasting room. It's 100% locally owned, with grassroots in the homebrewing community and a strong passion for craft beer. Survival Camp is certainly a force to be reckoned with. sitting at 9.5% abv, but undeniably crushable. The hop bill includes Citra, Mosaic and El Dorado hops. It's loaded with a tropical fruit blanket of juicy deliciousness.

They've brewed a traditional Witbier and added some gin botanicals including juniper berries, green cardamom, orange peel and seeds of paradise. Be sure to give this can a little swirl before pouring.

The Establishment Cool Waves Alberta Style: Hazy IPA 473ml

The Establishment is a brewery and taproom located in Calgary's growing Barley Belt brewing district. Superflux Wonderlove British Columbia Style: Hazy IPA w/Phantasm 473ml

Superflux Beer Company is a fantastic brewery nestled between Strathcona and East Vancouver. With this location, they're joining a number of other breweries, that have had beer lovers flocking to this area for a while now. Wonderlove is a mouthwatering IPA brewed with 'Phantasm'. This is a powder derived from New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc grapes, known for creating aromas of grapefruit and cantaloupe.

Winterlong British Columbia Style: Stout 473ml

Marko and Meghan Marianovic have been homebrewing for 10 years and finally made a huge jump, opening their own brewery in 2014. Their theory was simply brewing beers they wanted to drink, with extra bold flavours. This rich stout called Sweater Weather; will certainly keep you warm on those frisky nights. It pours jet black and has aromas of black fruit. chocolate, oatmeal cookies, coffee bean and spiced licorice.

Dog Island Lip Pointer Alberta Style: Double IPA 473ml

Dog Island Brewing was founded in 2013 by partners Ben Fiddler and Chad Paulson. In addition to being trade workers in the oil patch, both were also avid home brewers in their hometown of Slave Lake. Just recently, the team at Dog Island announced their yearly release called Lip Pointer. It's a double IPA brewed with a whirlpool of Mosaic, Citra and El Dorado hops. You'll taste <u>a mix</u> of tropical and citrus fruit with a hint of light pine on a warm finish.
